


New Section – Contact and Vendor Groups

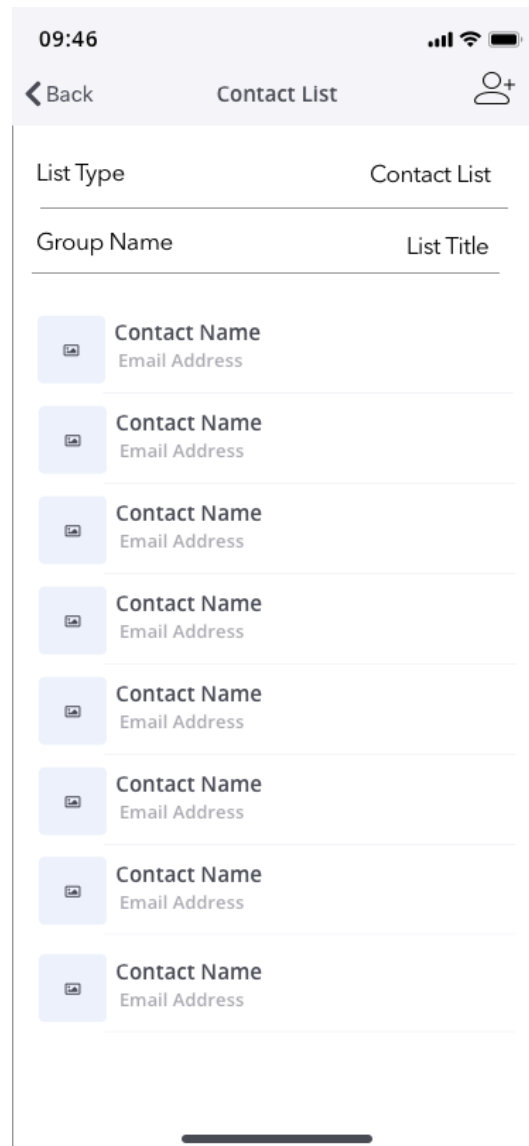

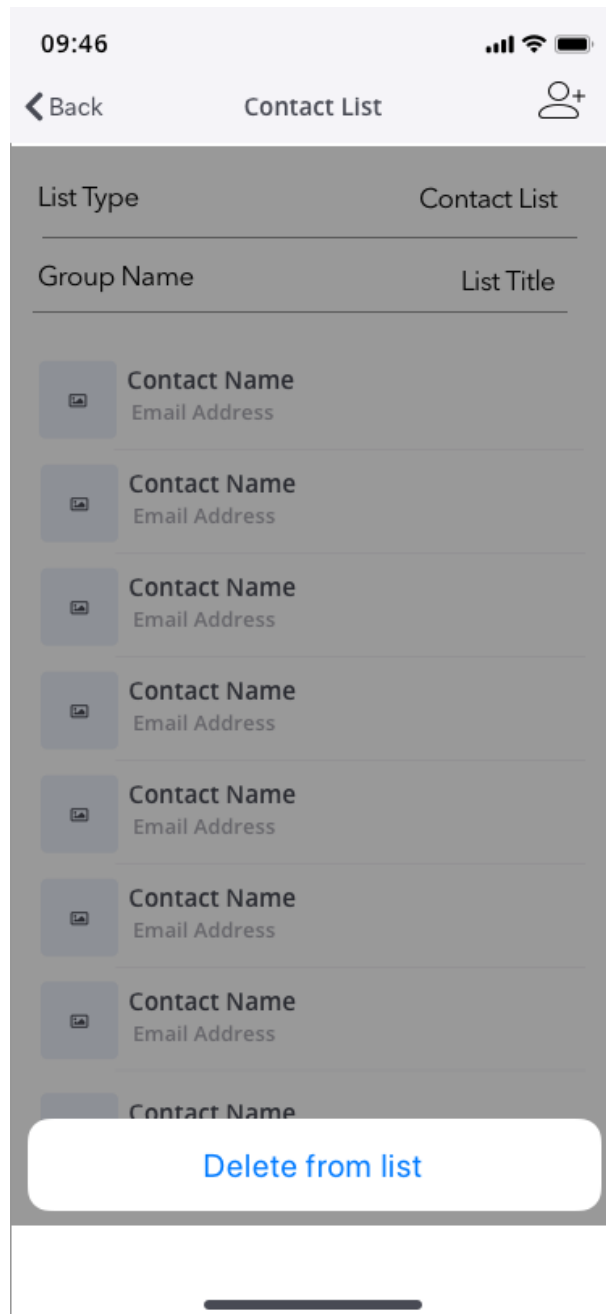
